



Executive Management and Succession

PURPOSE

The purpose of Volume 3, of The University of Arizona Campus Emergency Response Plan is to provide a clear line of the Executive Management and succession in the absence of the President of the University of Arizona, and when multiple members of the executive management team are absent from the campus.

SUCCESSION

While the President is responsible for the management of the University at all times, when he/she is not in the Tucson metropolitan area or is unavailable for other reasons, the Executive Vice President/Provost will assume management responsibilities for the University of Arizona.

In the absence of the President and Executive Vice President/Provost, the Senior Vice President for Business Affairs will assume management responsibilities for the University of Arizona.

In absence of the President, Executive Vice President/Provost and Senior Vice President the order of succession is:

- i. Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies and Economic Development
- ii. Vice President for Instruction
- iii. Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel
- iv. Vice President for External Relations
- v. Vice President for Outreach
- vi. Vice President for Student Affairs and Dean of Students
- vii. Vice President and Senior Associate to the President

The President will notify the Executive Management Team of the dates when he/she is unavailable. The Executive Management Team will be responsible for notification to appropriate university officials.

TRAVEL OF EXECUTIVE MANAGEMENT TEAM

To help ensure the continuity of business, the members of the Executive Management Team will not travel together on the same commercial/private carrier at the same time. At least one of the members will always travel separately.

The President, when feasible and traveling within the United States, will obtain a rental car to provide the President with a method of transportation in the event the commercial carriers are unable to operate.
